

Chichester Cursillo 2000 - 2025

June 14th/15th saw a gathering at Wychcroft to celebrate 25 years of Cursillo in the Chichester Diocese.



Our first weekend Chichester#1 was held March 23rd - 26th 2000. Cursillo was gifted to Chichester by the Canterbury Diocese, and its formation didn't happen without a great deal of hard work being undertaken, behind the scenes, to set up the structure and support needed to ensure a successful programme.

A small steering group was formed to undertake all the necessary tasks, source a venue, organise equipment, co-ordinate a programme - and so much more. It was also necessary to build on the existing number of Cursillistas (those who had already become cursillistas in other diocese) to enable a staff group to be formed for the first weekends. Individuals were encouraged to attend weekends in other Diocese - some Canterbury and some in Exeter, so as to

ensure that there were cursillistas in Chichester ready to take the lead.

The first weekend took place at Wychcroft – the Southwark Diocesan Retreat House - a venue that has been used for all our weekends and which so many of us have come to love. Staff for that first weekend came from Canterbury and Chichester Diocese, with the weekend being dedicated to St Barnabas, with 13 pilgrims in attendance.

Since then weekends have been occurring regularly - we aim for two weekends a year, but sometimes it has been to have only one. Over this time 355 pilgrims have attended coming from parishes across the Diocese.

A small team came together about a year ago to plan for the Celebration weekend, with Maggie Williams being asked to co-ordinate the event. The resulting weekend was a joyous occasion, with much laughter and so many memories.



25 Cursillistas booked to stay for the full weekend (all the rooms were occupied), with others joining for Saturday, Sunday or both. We were very pleased to welcome Helen Taubman, BACC President, who joined us for the whole weekend, and very grateful for her thoughtful and informative contributions to the weekend. There were cursillistas attending from Chichester#1 and Chichester #35.



The weekend was an opportunity to share fellowship, worship, prayer, singing and memories, and gave us all a chance to look back and remember and reflect on how far we have come, and to give some thought to the future and how we can keep growing.

A fairly informal programme had been arranged to allow as much sharing of memories and thoughts as possible, and to give everyone the opportunity to relax and celebrate, and to enjoy the peace of Wychcroft. We were blessed with some beautiful weather so were able to make full use of the outside space as well.

This was a Cursillo weekend so of course there was a mix of creative activities with simple craft activities set up for all to try, alongside prayer stations, and worship and of course singing.

Stephen Lucas, aided by Maggie Williams, encouraged us all to sing - and sing we did - visiting old favourites and learning some new songs as well.

And of course a weekend at Wychcroft would not be complete with some mention of the food, which as usual was all we could wish for and more. Our thanks to Richard and Wendy and all their staff for looking after us so well.



There are so many things to remember when you look back over 25 years, some good, some funny, some sad. In the hall which was of course full of butterflies and rainbow coloured decorations, we had the opportunity to look at so many pictures from past weekends, and also to look back through the Register recording so many names. It gave us all the chance to remember with gratitude all those who have contributed so much to Chichester Cursillo.



Before concluding the weekend with a Eucharist in the chapel we took the opportunity to give some thought on how we can build on what we already have -how can we continue to grow.

The general feeling was that each of us has some part in this as the best way to spread the message and share the love and joy that we have experienced is by word of mouth - make a friend, be a friend and bring a friend to Jesus. It was also felt that sharing some of our thoughts on the website could be beneficial and to this. Stephen is suggesting that some of our experiences could be shown on the website to inspire others.

As part of the celebrations to mark 25 years, there was a new addition to be found in the chapel. This beautiful lectern fall was designed and created by Annette Thomas. I am sure you will agree it is a beautiful addition .Our grateful thanks to Annette for all that went in to creating this.





A great deal of work went into making the weekend and I would like to record thanks to all the team who made it possible. My thanks also to all those who created all the little touches that always make our weekends so special - to Helena Buque, Irene Adams, Annette Thomas, Linda Pudney, Sue Bowman, Stephen Lucas and of course Maggie Williams.

Chichester Cursillo is 25 years old and we owe a huge debt of thanks to all those who have worked so hard over those 25 years to first bring Cursillo into Chichester Diocese and then make it what it is. Thank you.


